


2016 LEAF COLLECTION SCHEDULE

The DPW will begin collection in Section 1 on Monday, **NOVEMBER 7th** and continue until the last street in Section 2 has been completed. **After the truck has gone by your house, DO NOT rake leaves to the curb. Remaining leaves MUST be bagged** for regular pickup by Republic Services. Bagged leaf pickup ends the last Monday of November – **November 28, 2016**. The City thanks you for your help and cooperation in this matter. If you have questions, please call City Hall at (810) 694-1118.



Section 1: Week of **November 7th**. **No leaves should be raked to the street after 7:00 AM on November 7th.**

Section 2: Week of **November 14th**. **No leaves should be raked to the street after 7:00 AM on November 14th.**

If you use curbside pickup, please pay close attention to the above map and the schedule of pickups for each section. The City is divided into two sections as shown above. Leaves must be raked into the curb of the street by 7:00 A.M. on Monday morning of the week your section is to be collected. The machine cannot reach behind the curb. The machine used to collect leaves is designed for vacuuming leaves only. If brush or grass clippings are in the pile, they cannot be collected.

The DPW will begin on Monday morning and continue until the section scheduled for pickup is complete. This process is highly variable and it is impossible to gauge exactly when any particular street will be done. **Please be aware that should a critical situation arise, leaf collection will be interrupted until the situation is resolved.** Inclement weather affects the leaf pick up by the City. If it rains or snows for several days, leaves will be wet and the City machine will not operate. In that case, it may be necessary to bag the leaves for pick up by Republic Services on your regular trash day. **Their last yard waste collection day is Monday, November 28, 2016.**
