
Welcome to the City of Grand Blanc Downtown Development Authority (DDA) Newsletter, Just About Downtown. This newsletter



CITY OF GRAND BLANC DDA ON-GOING, SHORT-TERM AND LONG-TERM PROPOSED IMPROVEMENTS

- Business Development The DDA will focus on assisting existing businesses and promoting new businesses that benefit the community.
- Community Service Support The DDA will work with local services and social organizations on projects that
 promote community spirit and well-being.
- \sim Design Plan The DDA will complete an overall design plan for the downtown district.
- ~ Street Beautification The DDA will adequately landscape and enhance the streets within the DDA district.
- Surface Parking Development The DDA will allocate funds to design and develop the parking lots within the area
 of Grand Boulevard.
- \sim Parking Structure Development The DDA will allocate funds to support development of a parking structure.
- Outdoor Pavilion/Skating Rink The DDA will allocate funds to construct an arena for hosting events and providing shelter.
- ~ Street improvements The DDA will allocate funds as determined by the Design Plan.
